PREFACE

How to Use This Workbook

This workbook follows the order of a live deliverance service and is designed for personal prayer, small-group intercession, and ministry distribution. Each section can stand alone, or you can pray through the entire workbook in one extended session (approximately 2–3 hours).

Before you begin

- Find a quiet place where you will not be interrupted.
- Have your Bible, a glass of water (or communion elements if available), and anointing oil on hand.
- Have a pen and journal to record what the Holy Spirit reveals.
- Plead the blood of Jesus over yourself, your home, and your loved ones before opening your mouth in prayer.

The flow of this workbook

- Part One — Preparation: worship, thanksgiving, repentance, and inviting the Holy Spirit.
- Part Two — Understanding: a teaching on the spirit of Jezebel from Scripture, so deliverance is rooted in knowledge.
- Part Three — Deliverance: renunciations, breaking of curses, and warfare prayers against this spirit.
- Part Four — Declarations & Sealing: proclamations of victory, prayers for spouses and children, salvation prayer, and a closing covering.

A note on manifestations.

During deliverance you may cough, yawn, burp, sneeze, weep, tremble, or feel heat or release. These are normal as the Holy Spirit dislodges what does not belong. Do not be afraid. Stay focused on Jesus, keep praying, and let the Spirit do His work.

PART ONE

Preparation

1 • Enter with Worship

Before warfare, we worship. Worship lifts the eyes of your heart off the battle and onto the King who has already won it. Begin this time by singing or quietly declaring these truths over your spirit.

Songs to enter into His presence

- As the Deer — "You alone are my strength, my shield; to You alone may my spirit yield."
- I Surrender All — "All to Jesus I surrender; all to Him I freely give."
- You Deserve the Glory — "There is no one else like You."
- Above All — "You lived to die, rejected and alone... like a rose trampled on the ground, You took the fall and thought of me above all."
- In the Glory of Your Presence — "We Your temple give You reverence; so arise from Your rest and be blessed by our praise."

Pause and pray: "Holy Spirit, take full control of this service. Let angels of the Lord ascend and descend in this place. Let every yoke be lifted, every burden removed, and let the fire of God fall upon my life and household. I cover this room, this gathering, and my family in the blood of Jesus, and I mark us as a Passover to every interference of the wicked. In Jesus' name."

2 • Thanksgiving

"I will praise thee, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvellous works. I will be glad and rejoice in thee: I will sing praise to thy name, O thou most High. When mine enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at thy presence."

— Psalm 9:1-6 (KJV)

David did not wait until everything was perfect; he praised God after every victory and remembered His faithfulness. As you gather here, remember: He has protected you, provided for you, preserved your life from the snares of the wicked. Some who left home today never returned, but you are here. Begin to thank Him.

Pray aloud

- Thank You, Lord, for the breath in my lungs and the life in my body.
- Thank You for protecting my going out and my coming in.
- Thank You for daily bread, for answered prayer, for my family and loved ones.

- Thank You for fighting battles I never saw — arrows of the wicked that did not land.
- Thank You for the blood of Jesus that bought me as a first-born.
- Every complaint, I turn into praise. Every worry, I turn into thanksgiving.
- Who am I, O Lord, that You have done this for me? (2 Samuel 7:18)

3 • Repentance

Before we seek deliverance, breakthrough, healing, or restoration, we must come before God with repentance. Sin is an obstacle that the enemy uses to resist your deliverance — we must remove it.

“Repent then and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.”

— Acts 3:19

“I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid... and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin.”

— Psalm 32:5

Pray aloud

- Father, forgive me of every sin known and unknown. Wash me with the blood of Jesus.
- Cleanse me from all unrighteousness. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.
- Forgive every accusation of the wicked against my life. Let every voice of condemnation be silenced by the blood of Jesus at Calvary.
- Have mercy on me, O Lord. Let Your mercy be new every morning over my life.
- Let every burden I have carried be lifted, and every bondage be broken, in Jesus' name.

4 • Invite the Holy Spirit

The disciples walked with Jesus, yet they were instructed to wait until they received power from on high. When the Holy Ghost fell, fear disappeared, chains broke, and boldness was released. You cannot pray Jezebel out in your own strength — you need the Spirit of God.

“When the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind... and there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.”

— Acts 2:1-4

Pray aloud

- Holy Spirit, fill this place. Fill my mind, my heart, my body, my home.

- Baptize me with fresh fire from heaven. Let the fire of God consume every work of darkness against my life.
- Holy Spirit, lead me. Direct my prayers. Reveal the roots of every problem.
- Bring divine awareness — let me not fall asleep, let me not be distracted, let me not give up early.
- Holy Spirit, scatter every enemy. Restore what has been stolen. Renew my strength.
- Let rivers of living water flow from within me, in Jesus' name.

Then pray in the Spirit for at least one minute. Let the Holy Ghost take over the atmosphere.

PART TWO

Understanding the Spirit of Jezebel

Your first deliverance is your understanding. The Lord said, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge" (Hosea 4:6). Before you war, know what you are warring against.

Where the spirit comes from

In 1 Kings 18, Elijah confronts the prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel. Behind those prophets stands a queen — Jezebel, the wife of Ahab. She fed 450 prophets of Baal and 400 prophets of the groves at her own table (1 Kings 18:19). She had murdered the Lord's prophets and silenced the true voice of God in the land (1 Kings 18:4).

The fire of God fell on Carmel. The prophets of Baal were slain. Yet in 1 Kings 19, a single threat from Jezebel sent Elijah — the same Elijah who had just called down fire — running into the wilderness, asking God to take his life. This is the signature of the Jezebel spirit: it does not always kill you outright; it wears you down with fear, intimidation, and despair, especially right after victory.

In Revelation 2:20, Jesus rebukes a church for tolerating "that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess." The same spirit that operated in the Old Testament queen had taken up residence in the New Testament church. That is why Christians refer to Jezebel as a spirit — it outlives the woman and continues its assignment wherever it is welcomed.

"Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols."

— Revelation 2:20

Characteristics of the Jezebel spirit

This spirit is not limited to women. It operates in men, in women, in pastors, in spouses, in church leaders, in choir members, in friends. The Bible calls its operation witchcraft (2 Kings 9:22). Galatians 5:22 lists the fruit of the Spirit and ends with self-control. The fruit of Jezebel is the opposite — people-control.

1 • Rebellion against God's authority

Jezebel refused to repent. She was not restrained by the fear of God or of men. She was passionate in pursuing evil worship and unrepented sin (Revelation 2:21).

2 • Manipulation, intimidation, control

"What peace, so long as the whoredoms of thy mother Jezebel and her witchcrafts are so many?" (2 Kings 9:22). Manipulation, intimidation, and the impulse to control people is the witchcraft of Jezebel. It divides leaders, churches, choirs, friendships, and marriages.

3 · Fear, despair, and suicidal thoughts

"He arose, and went for his life... and requested for himself that he might die" (1 Kings 19:3–4). After Elijah's greatest victory, fear came. Cycles of burnout and despair after intense fasting or prayer are a fingerprint of this spirit. You finish 21 days of fasting, and suddenly someone comes to you in a dream — sleeping with you, feeding you — to make you feel defeated. When the enemy cannot attack you head-on, he tries to wear you out.

4 · Seduction and sexual immorality

When Jehu came to Jezreel, Jezebel painted her face, tied her head, and looked out of the window (2 Kings 9:30). She got ready for the man of God. This spirit targets ministries and those in spiritual authority — when leaders fall, congregations scatter. It drives pornography, adultery, masturbation, soul ties, lustful dreams, and the lure to compromise.

"Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the Lord to blaspheme..."

— 2 Samuel 12:14

5 · False doctrine and false prophecy

Jezebel calls herself a prophetess. She teaches a gospel that is not the gospel of Jesus Christ — persuading the culture of the church through her teachings. No matter how good a person's outward appearance is, if their doctrine contradicts Scripture, stay clear of them and their message.

6 · Unrepentance

"I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not" (Revelation 2:21). There are consequences to allowing this spirit to operate. If you notice these patterns in your behavior or in those around you, repent and confront it.

Signs the Jezebel spirit is operating in your life

As you read this list, the Holy Spirit will highlight what applies. Do not be afraid — exposure is the beginning of freedom.

- Intense fear and intimidation; panic at small things even after prayer.
- Persistent discouragement, depression, or suicidal thoughts — especially right after victory.
- Cycles of burnout after fasting, prayer, or deliverance — followed by sexual dreams or attacks.
- Division in your family, ministry, friendships, marriage, or workplace that you cannot explain.
- Spiritual compromise, manipulation, or control — in you or coming against you.
- Opposition to your prayer life: falling asleep, losing focus, not understanding the Bible.
- Confusion in the room when worship begins; an unexplainable irritation with certain people.
- Sexual sin you cannot stop — pornography, masturbation, adultery, lust, fantasy.
- A spouse who fights your salvation, mocks your prayer, insults your appearance, or beats you when you return from church.
- Threats from a pastor or leader: “If you leave this church, you (or your children) will die.”
- Attacks on your purpose, calling, ministry, or destiny — a constant pull to give up.
- Children losing interest in life, isolating, expressing suicidal thoughts.

Remember: our victory is not against people, but against spiritual forces (Ephesians 6:12). Jesus Christ has already conquered every power through His death and resurrection (Colossians 2:14–15; 1 John 3:8). You are not fighting for victory — you are fighting from victory.

PART THREE

Deliverance Prayers

Take your communion elements, a glass of water, and your anointing oil. If you do not have communion wine, water and oil are enough — the Holy Spirit consecrates them as you pray.

“They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony.”

— Revelation 12:11

“Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

— Luke 10:19

1 • Open the deliverance with the blood

Say aloud, with authority:

- > Blood of Jesus, speak better things over my life right now.
- > Free me from every authority of Jezebel, in the mighty name of Jesus.
- > Deliver me from the oppression of every Jezebelic spirit in my life.
- > Every attack against my health, my peace, my mind — be removed in Jesus' name.
- > Every burden that is not of God, be lifted off my life now.
- > Every voice speaking confusion in my life, be silenced in Jesus' name.
- > Father, expose every deception and lead me into truth, in Jesus' name.

2 • Bind and break Jezebel's authority

Drink the blood (or water) and declare:

- > Thank You, Father, for the authority to battle against the controlling powers of witchcraft attacking my life, in Jesus' name.
- > By the blood of Jesus, I bind every negative thought. I break the powers of confusion. I break the powers of torment and fear over my life.
- > I break the powers of control and manipulation over my life. I cut every soul tie of manipulation from my life.
- > I take captive every high thought that is contrary to the Word of God in my life (2 Corinthians 10:5).
- > I submit my will, my thoughts, and my life to the Lordship of Jesus Christ, and I plead the blood of Jesus over my mind.

- > I command stability and order to prevail in my soul, in the mighty name of Jesus.
- > By the blood of Jesus, I break the power of witchcraft. I break the power of deception. I break the power of seduction. I break the power of sorcery. I break the power of intimidation.
- > I decree my freedom from dark powers, from the spirit of Jezebel, from false prophetic words, from every manipulation in my life.
- > I decree my freedom from soul ties, from lying eyes, from lying lips, from lying dreams, from wrong visions, by the blood of Jesus.
- > I repent of every known and unknown sin in my life. I submit myself to the Lordship of Jesus Christ and to His will.
- > I clothe myself with God's armor and take up the weapons of my warfare — not carnal, but mighty in God for the pulling down of strongholds (2 Corinthians 10:4).
- > I repent of rebellion. I repent of pride and arrogance. I repent of manipulation and vain desires.
- > I repent of disrespecting the fivefold ministry gifts and leaders God has set in my life.
- > I renounce wrong accusations. I renounce wrong associations. I tear down every stronghold of witchcraft, false motives, and hidden agendas in my life.
- > I break every spirit of jealousy tormenting my life. I bind every spirit of jealousy from my life by the blood of Jesus.

Pause and confess: "Lord, if I confess my sins, You are faithful and just to forgive me of my sins and cleanse me of all unrighteousness. I receive Your forgiveness and Your righteousness now, in Jesus' name." (1 John 1:9)

3 • Destroy the cords between you and Jezebel

Address the spirit directly. Pray these declarations slowly, with focus. After each one, you may cough, yawn, weep, or feel release — let it come.

Cord of occultic powers

I now address you, Jezebel, in the spirit realm. I declare that I recognize the cord of occultic powers between you and your seat in my life. I now take the sword of the Spirit and the blood of Jesus, and I destroy this power. Come out of my life now, in Jesus' name.

Cord of compromise

I now take the sword of the Spirit and I destroy the cord of compromise in my life and in my family's life, in the mighty name of Jesus.

Cord of immorality

I declare that I recognize the cord of immorality between you and your seat in my life. I now take the sword of the Spirit and the blood of Jesus, and I destroy this cord. Come out of my life. I command every spirit of manipulation, intimidation, domination, occultic powers, immorality, and adultery to come out now, in Jesus' name.

Cord of intimidation and manipulation

I now address you, devil, in the spirit realm. I am not afraid. I recognize the cord of intimidation and manipulation between you and your seat in my life. By the sword of the Spirit and the blood of Jesus, I destroy this cord. Come out of my life now, by air or by liquid, in Jesus' name.

Cord of false religion

I now address you, Jezebel, cast down in the spirit realm. I recognize the cord of false religion — the wall of religion — between you and your seat in my life. I take the sword of the Spirit and the blood of Jesus, and I destroy this cord of false religion. Loose me and let me go, in Jesus' name. (John 4:24 — "God is a spirit, and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.")

4 • A declaration of divorce from Jezebel

Repeat aloud, over and over, until it rises from your spirit:

"I rebuke the spirit of Jezebel in my life."

"I rebuke the spirit of Jezebel in my life."

"I rebuke the spirit of Jezebel in my life."

- > I now declare a divorce with the spirit of Jezebel in my life.
- > I declare a cancellation of all worship Jezebel has ever received from me, my ancestors, or my descendants, in Jesus' name.
- > I declare the nullification of any and every covenant ever made with this spirit, by the blood of Jesus.
- > Spirit of Jezebel, I let you go. I no longer carry you. You will not return.
- > I renounce every death-spirit by the authority of the name of Jesus Christ.
- > I now take this seat in my life and hand it over to the kingdom of God. Jesus, sit on the throne of my heart, my mind, and my will.

5 • Breaking the curses connected to Jezebel

Some of these curses have come down ancestral lines; others have entered through your own involvement with the spirits behind them. As each curse is named, say aloud: "I command this curse to come out of my life now, in Jesus' name."

- Curse of division
- Curse of divorce
- Curse of male/female conflict
- Curse of 'almost there but never arriving'
- Curse of death in the family, the home, the marriage, the body
- Curse of suicide and self-destruction
- Curse of bitterness and unforgiveness
- Curse of humiliation
- Curse of nakedness and shame
- Curse of slavery
- Curse of insanity
- Curse of homosexuality and lesbianism
- Curse of cancer
- Curse of loss of children
- Curse of loss of marriage or partner
- Curse of disaster
- Curse of evil
- Curse of loneliness and isolation
- Curse of oppression
- Curse of witchcraft
- Curse of presbyopic (familiar-spirit) witchcraft
- Curse of poverty and stagnation

Pray: "Lord, change every one of these curses into blessings in my life, in my ancestors, and in my descendants. Reverse them by the blood of Jesus."

6 • "Loose me and let me go"

Anoint your forehead, your hands, your feet, and any place of pain or affliction with oil. Pray aloud, slowly:

- > I speak destruction over every altar where the spirit of Jezebel has been receiving worship in my family.
- > "David built there an altar unto the Lord, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the Lord was intreated for the land" (2 Samuel 24:25).
- > The stronghold in my life where Jezebel has lived is now destroyed. The throne of Christ Jesus is erected in that place.
- > By the power of the Holy Ghost, I speak withering and destruction and death over every fruit of manipulation through witchcraft in my life.
- > Whatever I have eaten in dreams from this spirit — in wrong churches, wrong gatherings, idol food, water from strange altars — come out of my vessel now, by air or by liquid, through every opening of my body, in Jesus' name.
- > If I was seduced by any false prophet and have been weakened since — loose me and let me go.
- > If I was cursed by any leader saying, "If you leave this church your life will not remain the same," I cancel that word by the blood of Jesus now.
- > Lord, remove every leaven that caused me to walk under the control of these spirits — from my thinking, my will, my emotions, and my body. Be loose, in Jesus' name.

7 • Let the spirit of Elijah arise

"And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse."

— Malachi 4:6

- > Spirit of Elijah, arise within me and expose every Jezebel spirit operating against me — in my body, in my home, in my church, in the body of Christ.
- > Let the hearts of the fathers be turned toward the children, and the children toward the fathers.
- > Let disobedience be turned toward the wisdom of the righteous, in Jesus' name.
- > Let spiritual fathers and mothers arise to lead us in the path of righteousness.
- > Foul spirit of Jezebel, I stand against you — wherever I go, in every place where I am sent.

- > "Whatsoever I bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatsoever I loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Matthew 18:18). Therefore I bind up the spirit of Jezebel in the heavenlies, and I loose her hold over my life tonight.
- > I call upon the holy warrior angels of God to battle on my behalf, in Jesus' name.

Say aloud, with full authority:

"There is no throne for Jezebel in my mind."

"There is no throne for Jezebel in my home."

"There is no throne for Jezebel in my marriage."

"There is no throne for Jezebel in my family."

"There is no throne for Jezebel in my ministry."

"There is no throne for you, Jezebel. You are defeated. In Jesus' name."

PART FOUR

Declarations, Restoration & Sealing

1 • For your spouse and your marriage

The battle is not against your husband or your wife — it is against the spirit attacking them. Pray for them with mercy, not with bitterness.

- Father, deliver my spouse from pride, seduction, lust, perversion, rebellion, selfishness, fornication, and adultery.
- Deliver every husband and every wife in this prayer from sexual sin, immorality, and adultery.
- Loose every idolatry, every soul tie, every wrong covenant.
- I renounce and remove the spirit of Jezebel from the throne of my spouse's heart, in Jesus' name.
- I bind every witchcraft attack and seal my home, my family, my business, and my workplace.
- Let every wickedness of Jezebel be exposed in my home and in my marriage.
- Lord, open my eyes to recognize the awkwardness of men and women operating in this spirit around me — in the church and in the workplace.
- Restore my marriage. Restore every marriage in this prayer, in Jesus' name.

2 • For your children and the next generation

The spirit of Jezebel attacks destinies from infancy. It is the spirit behind a child who loses interest in life, who isolates, who wants to die.

- Lord, touch my children right now. Deliver them from the spirit of Jezebel.
- Cancel every suicidal thought, every feeling of not belonging, every loss of joy in my children, in Jesus' name.
- Let every power working against my children's lives, testimonies, and destinies be destroyed.
- Let the blood of Jesus open doors of favor and divine opportunity for them.
- Let every cycle of generational principle of failure be broken now in my home, in my family, and with my children.
- Lord, let the peace of the Lord reign in my home and in the lives of my children, in Jesus' name.

3 · For finances, calling, and future

- > Every attack against my finances, be defeated tonight by the blood of Jesus.
- > Lord, bless the works of my hands.
- > Every spirit of stagnation and loss, be loosed in Jesus' name.
- > Lord, lead me into greater victory from this day forward.
- > Every power opposing my prayers, be destroyed in Jesus' name.
- > Every work of darkness against my home, fail in Jesus' name.
- > Blood of Jesus, protect me and my family. Preserve me and my family.
- > Father, let Your glory be revealed in my life.
- > Every plan of the enemy against me shall not prosper from now, in the name of Jesus.
- > I declare complete freedom in Jesus Christ.

4 • Thanksgiving for deliverance

Lift your hands. Speak it — whether you feel it or not. Faith is not a feeling.

"Thank You, Lord Jesus, for deliverance."

"Thank You, Lord Jesus, for victory over these spirits."

"I am delivered, by the power of the Holy Ghost, in the mighty name of Jesus."

"I claim this victory through the blood of Jesus Christ and His precious Word. I triumph in His glory."

5 • Prayer of salvation

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

— **Romans 10:13 (KJV)**

If you have never given your life to Jesus, or you want to rededicate your life to Christ, pray this prayer aloud:

"Lord Jesus, I repent of my sins and surrender my life. Wash me clean. I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, that He died on the cross for my sins and rose again on the third day for my victory. I believe this in my heart and confess with my mouth that Jesus is my Savior and Lord. I receive eternal life in Jesus' name. Amen."

If you prayed this prayer, you are born again. You have entered a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Write today's date in your Bible and your journal — this is your day of new beginnings. Keep God first. Learn to pray, to fast, and to forgive. Prayer is simply talking to God the way you would talk to a friend.

CLOSING

The Sealing & The Covering

“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty... Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the Most High, thy habitation; there shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.”

— Psalm 91:1, 9–11

Pray this closing prayer aloud

- Father, I thank You for tonight, by the power of the Holy Ghost.
- I plead the blood of Jesus over my room, my bed, my pillow, and every place where I will rest tonight.
- I soak my home, my family, my ministry, and everything connected to my life in the blood of Jesus, and I mark it as a Passover.
- Let the blood of Jesus surround me and shield me throughout the night.
- Lord, send Your angels to ascend and descend in my room and in my home.
- Let no weapon formed against me prosper. Let no plague come near my dwelling.
- Preserve me as I sleep and as I wake. Preserve me in my going out and my coming in — from every accident, every violence, every sickness, every retaliation to this prayer.
- Father, as I leave this place of prayer, I do not leave alone. I leave with Your presence, Your protection, and Your covering.
- In the mighty name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Amen.

“The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the sweet fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us now and forevermore. To Him alone be all the glory of our lives, and we shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever and ever. Amen.”
