Luke 1:37 — With God all things are possible

DAY 1

The Power of Thanksgiving

Psalm 100:4 (KJV)

"Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name."

Reflection

Pastor Kiki teaches that thanksgiving is your spiritual key. When you thank God, He activates His presence, secures His protection, and multiplies His provision over your life and family. Many pray only for what they do not yet have, but the wise believer first thanks God for what He has already done — and gratitude opens Him to do more. The very fact that you are alive today is proof that God has been faithful. Begin your deliverance the way the service began: with a heart of gratitude that the enemy cannot stand.

Prayer Points

- Father, I thank You for life, for protection, and for every battle You fought for me that I never saw.
- Thank You for covering my family, my children, and my home under the shadow of Your wings.
- Lord, let my thanksgiving stir the atmosphere and let the enemy hear my praise.

Declarations

- ◆ I enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise.
- ◆ I bless the Lord, and I forget not all His benefits.

Journaling

Write down five things God has already done for you this week. How does gratitude shift the way you face your battle today?

DAY 2

Closing the Legal Door (Repentance)

Isaiah 59:1–2 (KJV)

“Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: but your iniquities have separated between you and your God.”

Reflection

Before deliverance, every entrance of sin must be cleansed. Pastor Kiki explains that God is fully able to deliver us, but unconfessed sin creates a barrier and gives the enemy legal ground to afflict, delay, and bring confusion. Deliverance is not only about casting out demons — it is about aligning your life with God's promise. Tonight you repent, and every legal ground of the enemy is destroyed, every accusation silenced, and every chain broken. No sin will stand against your deliverance or your testimony.

Prayer Points

- Father, wash away my sins; create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit within me.
- Anything standing between my deliverance and me — Father, wash it away.
- Let every legal ground of the enemy in my life be destroyed by the blood of Jesus.

Declarations

- ◆ Every accusation against me is silenced in the name of Jesus.
- ◆ Every chain is broken; no sin stands against my deliverance.

Journaling

Is there anyone you have not forgiven? Name it honestly before God and release it. What legal door are you closing today?

DAY 3

Inviting the Holy Ghost

Zechariah 4:6 (KJV)

"Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts."

Reflection

Deliverance is not a human activity — it is a Holy Ghost operation. Pastor Kiki reminds us that without the Holy Spirit we can pray, but nothing shifts; we can shout, but no chains break. Yet when the Holy Ghost takes over, yokes are destroyed and chains fall, because darkness cannot stand His power. Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. Do not depend on yourself today. Invite the fire and presence of the Holy Ghost to saturate your atmosphere, expose every hidden thing, and make every stubborn spirit bow.

Prayer Points

- Holy Ghost, I need You today — come and take full control of my prayer and my atmosphere.
- Fall fresh upon me; let Your fire expose and remove anything the enemy has planted.
- Spirit of the Lord, direct my words, my actions, and my declarations.

Declarations

- ◆ Not by might, nor by power, but by His Spirit.
- ◆ Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is my liberty.

Journaling

Where do you most need to stop striving in your own strength and let the Holy Spirit take over? Write your invitation to Him.

DAY 4

Recognizing the Twisting Spirit

Job 41:1 (KJV)

"Canst thou draw out leviathan with an hook? or his tongue with a cord which thou lettest down?"

Reflection

Your understanding is your first open door to deliverance. Pastor Kiki teaches that as soon as you diagnose what is happening, you know where your prayers should go. Leviathan is a marine, serpent, twisting spirit that does not attack openly — it coils around destinies, marriages, ministries, and especially finances. It twists communication so words are heard differently than they were spoken, breeding misunderstanding, accusation, and division. Some battles cannot be won by human strength; what is impossible for men is nothing before God. Recognize the twisting, and aim your prayers with purpose.

Prayer Points

- Holy Ghost, open my eyes to recognize every twisting and dividing spirit operating around me.
- Lord, restore every relationship the enemy has tried to twist and divide.
- Expose every hidden work of Leviathan in my marriage, family, and finances.

Declarations

- ◆ My understanding is my first open door to deliverance.
- ◆ Every twisting of my words and relationships is broken in Jesus' name.

Journaling

Where have you seen constant misunderstanding or division without a clear cause? Ask the Holy Spirit to show you the spiritual root.

DAY 5

Breaking Pride and Anger

Proverbs 16:18 (KJV)

"Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall."

Reflection

Pastor Kiki warns that Leviathan works through the spirit of pride, which leaves trails of hurt everywhere it goes — broken marriages, backsliding, and destruction. It will not allow you to submit to authority, and it can stir an anger that cannot be controlled, until people say, 'Something took over me.' This is not ordinary; it is a spirit to be cast out. When you meet people bound by it, do not battle them in the flesh — pray for them and seek their deliverance. Today, renounce pride, arrogance, rage, and rebellion, and put away all bitterness as Ephesians commands.

Prayer Points

- Father, uproot every seed of pride and arrogance I cannot explain in myself.
- Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamour, and evil speaking be put away from me.
- I intercede for those bound by uncontrollable anger — set them free, Lord.

Declarations

- ◆ I renounce the spirit of pride and arrogance.
- ◆ I renounce anger, rage, rebellion, and mockery in the name of Jesus.

Journaling

Where has pride or anger cost you a relationship? Confess it, and write a prayer of humility before God.

DAY 6

The Blood of Jesus as Your Cover

Revelation 12:11 (KJV)

"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death."

Reflection

We overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony. Pastor Kiki marks every meeting as a Passover, covered by the blood of Jesus, rebuking every retaliation. The blood cleanses from all sin and, without its shedding, there is no remission. Plead the blood over your home, your family, and your destiny. Hold the blood of Jesus against every time waster and household power, and let your case be settled. The blood is not a ritual phrase — it is the legal, finished victory of Christ applied to your life.

Prayer Points

- Blood of Jesus, settle my case today and cover my family as a Passover.
- I plead the blood over my home, my children, and my destiny.
- By the blood of Jesus, every retaliation against my deliverance is broken.

Declarations

- ◆ The blood of Jesus settles my case.
- ◆ I hold the blood of Jesus against every time waster and household power.

Journaling

Name the specific situations you are placing under the blood of Jesus today. Write them as a declaration of faith.

DAY 7

Walking in Liberty

2 Corinthians 3:17 (KJV)

"Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty."

Reflection

When the Holy Ghost enters, freedom must manifest. Pastor Kiki declares that the Lord with His great sword punishes Leviathan and slays the dragon in the sea — God Himself fights and destroys this spirit from your life. Deliverance is not a one-time event but a walk; keep pressure through persistent prayer, thanksgiving, the Word, communion, and renunciation until breakthrough is sealed. Guard your liberty. Stay covered, stay grateful, and never battle a bound person in the flesh again — intercede instead, and walk free.

Prayer Points

- Lord, seal my deliverance and let Your liberty be permanent in my life.
- Teach me to guard my freedom through daily thanksgiving, the Word, and the blood.
- I declare my victory and walk in the liberty the Spirit has given me.

Declarations

- ◆ I declare my victory in the name of Jesus.
- ◆ Lord, You have set me free, and where Your Spirit is, there is my liberty.

Journaling

What does freedom look like for you this season? Write the daily habits you will keep to guard your liberty.
