Before You Begin

After today, and every time you come — after your deliverance — remember these nine pillars. Deliverance is not the end of the battle; it is the beginning of maintaining your freedom. Some demons leave quickly. Others have legal grounds and must be evicted persistently. These pillars are how you keep your house clean, guarded, and filled with the presence of God.

“When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man... then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself.” Keep the house filled — do not leave it empty.



Read Your Bible Daily

The Word of God is your daily bread and your daily defense.

Pillar 1 · Read Your Bible Daily

Read your Bibles daily. The Word is how you renew your strength, discern the voice of God, and starve every spirit that hates the truth. A daily portion of Scripture keeps your mind anchored and your spirit fed.

Make it a habit: a portion every morning, a portion every night. The enemy cannot stay where the Word dwells richly.



Be An Active Member Of A Christ-Centered Church

Some demons leave quickly — others have legal grounds and require persistence.

Pillar 2 · Active Church Membership

Be an active member of a Christ-centered church — especially if you come from a very difficult background. Some demons leave quickly because they came not long ago. Other demons have been there for years — they are relaxed in your life and operating.

They have legal grounds because somebody in the family — or you yourself — went into covenant with them and allowed them to stay. With those kinds of demons, it takes not just one deliverance session.

Old demons vs. new demons: newcomers leave easily — but the ones who have lived in your life for years are settled, and they must be evicted again and again.



The Squatters Parable

Why you must be persistent.

Pillar 3 · The Squatters Parable

Demons are like squatters in your house. You allowed them in. You made them comfortable. They lived there 10, 20 years. Now you want your house back.

Demons are like people you allow into your house — that you yourself have built. You allow them into an empty house. You told them they can stay. You made them very comfortable. They eat your food, use your bed, use everything that belongs to you. You told them to use it for free — that it is theirs.

They lived in your house for ten years, twenty years, sometimes one year, sometimes six months. That is how demons are. It is like people you invite to squat in your house. And you told them to do whatever they want — live freely, control whatever they want, drive your cars, use your bed, shower and everything. No complaints. They are free.

Then all of a sudden you come and say, "I want my house back."

Pillar 3 · The Squatters Parable (cont.)

In the beginning they will not understand — because you are the same person who said “live here for free, don’t go anywhere.” So when you come and say “I want you to leave” — they say, “How? How can you do this?”

The ones who have only been there a year or two will leave. But the ones who have lived there ten, fifteen, twenty years — they will not understand to leave like that. They are settled in your house. It does not take coming once. It does not take coming a third time.

But when you keep coming — when they know you mean your words — they will go.

You are not coming alone with your mouth. You are coming with policemen, with angels, with the Holy Ghost, with armies, with fire, with storm — like an excavator. “I said go. I don’t want you here.”

The more you come with help, with powers, with the King of Glory — that is when they tremble and are afraid. That is how demons are.



The King Of Glory Prayer

Do not come alone — come with the King.

Pillar 4 · The King Of Glory Prayer

Psalm 24:7–8

"Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle."

PRAYER

This time I am not alone. I am not coming to move you alone. I am coming with the King. I am coming with the President who controls the heavens and the earth. I am coming with the Lord strong and mighty, mighty in battle. You cannot stay here. Be uprooted from your hidden places.

Until you have knowledge, you cannot tell them to go. When you recognize that certain things in your life are due to these demons, you begin to tell them to leave — and if you keep resisting them, they will go.



Bombard Them With The Blood Of Jesus

Use the blood all the time.

Pillar 5 · Bombard Them With The Blood

- Drink the blood often: “Any demon in me — be destroyed. Come out. You do not like the blood of Jesus.”
- Anoint yourself to bombard them.
- Read scripture in the mighty name of Jesus.
- Pray in tongues and in your understanding.
- Apply the blood of Jesus over yourself every day if you can.

“I am in deliverance, and I warfare with the blood of Jesus. I understand the use of the blood. Use it all the time.”



Renew Your Mind Daily

Cast down imaginations. Bring every thought captive to Christ.

Pillar 6 · Renew Your Mind Daily

2 Corinthians 10:5

"Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ."

Encourage yourself in the Lord daily. Guard your thought life as carefully as you guard your home — every imagination that exalts itself against God must be cast down before it takes root.

Practice tip: when a fearful or accusing thought rises, name it, refuse it, and replace it with a Scripture you have memorized. Renewal is a daily discipline.



Ask The Angels Of The Lord To Work

Ministering spirits, sent forth for the heirs of salvation.

Pillar 7 · Ask The Angels To Work

Hebrews 1:14

"Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?"

Ask the angels of the Lord on a daily basis to work on your behalf and to protect you. Do not get deliverance and keep quiet — continue to bombard them: "I am not going to make you comfortable in my system. You have been too comfortable for too long. Maybe my granddad brought you. Maybe my grandma brought you. Be cast out."

Warning: just as there are sexually-transmitted diseases, there are also sexually-transmitted demons. They enter through ungodly contact to destroy and hinder your life and destiny. Cast them out.



Walk In The Fruit Of The Spirit

Anything opposite of these opens a door for the enemy.

Pillar 8 · Walk In The Fruit Of The Spirit

Galatians 5:22–23

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law."

After every deliverance, practice:

- Practice your peace
- Practice your patience
- Practice your joy
- Practice your kindness

Leave it to God. Allow God to fight for you — He is the King of kings, the Lord of lords. When you let God fight for you, you win all your wars simply. Meditate on Galatians 5:22; it takes practice, and you get there.



Be Careful Who You Share Your Life With

Guard your testimonies and your progress.

Pillar 9 · Be Careful Who You Share With

Be careful of who calls and speaks to you. There are one or two members — even close ones — who may be attached to those who oppose you and may give them every piece of information.

When it comes to your work — your progress, your building, your work schedule — don't speak it too much to people, no matter how close they are. When your job goes well, that is when you are building, so they will attack your health, your strength, your mobility to bring problems at work.

PRAYER

Any witchcraft assignment over my life — whoever I am speaking to that is a point of contact, that comes to listen and go and destroy me — Lord, expose them. Lord, destroy them. Lord, cover me. Any monitoring spirit in human form — destroy them, blind them. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth.
