

Prophetic Directions

The Storm Is Over — May 30, 2026

- 1 Cross to the Other Side**
Jesus said, "Let us pass over unto the other side." Determine and declare it — this storm will not stay forever; your boat shall not sink and you shall reach your destination.
- 2 Declare the Storm Over — Even While It Rages**
Begin to prophesy into your storm. When Jesus speaks, every storm must obey. Proclaim by faith: "The storm is over."
- 3 Live in the NOW Faith**
"But I know that even NOW..." (John 11:22). If God is not in the now, He was not in the past. Ask now, believe now, receive now.
- 4 Recognize Jesus for Who He Truly Is**
Do not relate to a "gardener" when you have a Savior. Release your distorted expectations — letting go of how you think He should show up is deliverance itself.
- 5 Take the Oil and Speak Peace**
Anoint yourself and command, "Peace, be still," over every troubled area. The God who calmed the sea will calm every battle around you.
- 6 Do Not Fear — Faith Over Fear**
"Why are ye so fearful?" (Mark 4:40). Fear thou not, for He is with you (Isaiah 41:10). Faith is stronger than fear.
- 7 Cry Out: "God, Help Me"**
No one who has truly cried, "God, help me," has ever been denied His help. Open your mouth in your storm.
- 8 Stay in Thanksgiving — Cross Over**
End every month and battle in gratitude. Remember His faithfulness, then cross over into your new season expecting testimonies without delay.
