## FOREWORD A Word Before You Begin

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**B**eloved, I want you to hear heaven say it over your life today: the storm is over. For years I read the death of Lazarus as a story, until the Holy Spirit whispered that it was God talking to me — that He is interested in my natural needs, my health, my home, my destiny. And one morning the Lord arrested me with the cry of Martha: *“But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee”* (John 11:22). Even now. Not yesterday's faith, not someday's faith — now faith. The same Jesus who slept in the boat and then arose and said to the raging sea, “Peace, be still,” is in your boat tonight. He has not failed you, He will not forsake you, and He has already written “overcomer” upon your forehead. So lift your head, take your oil, open your mouth, and declare with me what the Lord has decreed: the storm is over.

## **PART ONE** Core Teaching Outline

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Seven movements from the teaching — from thanksgiving and repentance, through the Master in the storm, to the “even now” faith and the warfare decree that the storm is over.

### **1. Begin with Thanksgiving — Crossing Over into the New Month**

- Today is the thirtieth of the month; we give God thanks for another month completed and for bringing us far.
- We thank Him for the going out and the coming in — for protection, sustenance, and covering all month long.
- Many dangers we never saw, many attacks that never came, and the traps of the wicked that did not come to pass.
- Psalm 91:4 — He covered us with His feathers, and under His wings we trusted.
- We remember His faithfulness (Psalm 44) and prepare to cross over into the new month with gratitude.

### **2. Come in Repentance — Mercy Restores Access**

- Sin creates separation between us and our God; we ask for cleansing of anger, bitterness, and evil speaking.
- Ephesians 4:31-32 — put away bitterness, wrath, and clamour; be tenderhearted and forgiving.
- Psalm 51:1-4 — Have mercy upon me, O God; create in me a clean heart.
- Let no accusation of the enemy prevail against you or your destiny; mercy speaks louder than judgment.

### **3. Invite the Holy Ghost to Lead the Prayer**

- Romans 8:26 — the Spirit helps our infirmities and intercedes with groanings that cannot be uttered.
- Ezekiel 36:27 — I will put my Spirit within you and cause you to walk in my statutes.
- Call upon the fire of the Holy Ghost to consume every work of the enemy and to make your prayers powerful.

### **4. The Storm and the Master — Mark 4:35-41**

- Jesus said, “Let us pass over unto the other side,” then slept as a great storm arose.
- He arose, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, “Peace, be still” — and there was a great calm.
- “Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?” Faith is stronger than fear (Mark 4:40).
- Though He seemed asleep, He was still in the boat — He is present in your storm even when He seems silent.
- Even the wind and the sea obey Him; nothing is too difficult for our God.

## 5. Storms Are Universal — and You Are an Overcomer

- Storms come without warning: marital, financial, ministry, health, business, academic, and family storms.
- Bible witnesses came out of their storms: Noah, Joseph (prison to throne), Job, Jacob, Abraham & Sarah, David, Jonah, Paul, Daniel, Hannah.
- Genesis 21:1-2 — the Lord visited Sarah; after long waiting, God's promise was fulfilled and laughter came.
- “Overcomer” is written on you — it is your spiritual name; that is why the devil tests you.
- Deuteronomy 31:8 and James 1:12 — He goes before you and will not fail you; the one who endures receives the crown.

## 6. Do Not Fear, Do Not Worry — Cross to the Other Side

- Determine and declare: “I will cross to the other side” — this storm will not stay forever.
- Matthew 6:25-34 — consider the fowls of the air; how much more will your Father care for you?
- Philippians 4:6-7 — be anxious for nothing; the peace of God will keep your heart and mind.
- Isaiah 41:10 — Fear thou not, for I am with thee; Mark 11:22-23 — have faith in God and speak to the mountain.
- John 16:33 — in the world you have tribulation, but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

## 7. The “Even Now” Faith — John 11 (Mary, Martha & Lazarus)

- Mary went looking for Jesus weeping, expecting a corpse — and could not recognize the living God.
- We carry distorted expectations and misdiagnose Jesus as a “gardener” when He is Savior and Lord.
- Letting go of how we expect Jesus to show up is deliverance in and of itself.
- Martha declared, “But I know that even NOW, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee” (John 11:22).
- If God is not in the NOW, He was not in the past — ask now, believe now, for the storm is over now.

## 8. Warfare — Declare and Anoint: The Storm Is Over

- Take the anointing oil and speak peace over every troubled area of your life.
- Nahum 1:7 — the Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; John 14:27 — My peace I give to you.
- Psalm 107:29 — He maketh the storm a calm; command every satanic storm to reverse its direction.
- “Be still, and know that I am God” — my boat shall not sink; I proclaim that the storm is over.
- Cry out: “God, help me” — no one who has truly cried for God's help has ever been denied.

## PART TWO Scripture Anchors

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The Word she preached, in the King James Version — read these aloud as you pray.

### **Luke 1:37**

*For with God nothing shall be impossible.*

### **John 11:21-27**

*Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died. But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee. Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again. Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.*

### **Mark 4:35-41**

*And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships. And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full. And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish? And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith? And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?*

### **Mark 4:39-40**

*And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?*

### **Isaiah 41:10**

*Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.*

### **Psalms 91:4**

*He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.*

## **Nahum 1:7**

*The LORD is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.*

## **Matthew 6:25-34**

*Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.*

## PART TWO Scripture Anchors (cont.)

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### Mark 11:22-23

*And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.*

### Romans 8:26

*Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.*

### Philippians 4:6-7

*Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.*

### Genesis 21:1-2

*And the LORD visited Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did unto Sarah as he had spoken. For Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him.*

### Ezekiel 36:27

*And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.*

### John 14:27

*Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.*

### Psalms 51:1-4

*Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.*

### **Psalm 107:29**

*He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still.*

### **Deuteronomy 31:8**

*And the LORD, he it is that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.*

### **James 1:12**

*Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.*

### **John 16:33**

*These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.*

### **Ephesians 4:31-32**

*Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.*



## PART THREE Prophetic Declarations

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Speak these aloud, by faith, over your life, your home, and your destiny.

- 1 **I decree** the storm is over — over my life, my home, and my destiny, in the name of Jesus.
- 2 **I declare** that even now, whatsoever I ask of God, God shall give it me (John 11:22).
- 3 **I decree** peace, be still, over every raging wind contrary to my destiny.
- 4 **I declare** that the God who calmed the sea will calm every battle around me from this day.
- 5 **I decree** my boat shall not sink; I shall reach my destination and cross to the other side.
- 6 **I declare** faith stronger than fear; I will not be afraid, for God is with me (Isaiah 41:10).
- 7 **I decree** every satanic storm sent against my life is reversed and silenced by the fire of the Holy Ghost.
- 8 **I declare** my season of peace has arrived, and the peace of Christ shall rule in my home.
- 9 **I decree** every storm of fear, confusion, and anxiety is stilled in the name of Jesus.
- 10 **I declare** every storm of financial hardship is over; lack and debt are cancelled in Jesus' name.
- 11 **I decree** every storm of sorrow is replaced with joy, and every storm of tears comes to an end.
- 12 **I declare** every storm of bad news is overturned with good news in the name of Jesus.
- 13 **I decree** every storm of sickness and weakness be still; divine strength is mine.
- 14 **I declare** every storm against my calling and purpose fails in the name of Jesus.
- 15 **I decree** every storm of delay, stagnation, and reoccurring battles ceases now.
- 16 **I declare** the winds of failure and the winds of delay over my life fade away.
- 17 **I decree** every household witchcraft monitoring my success is destroyed by the angels of the Lord.
- 18 **I declare** no weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every evil altar against me receives fire.
- 19 **I decree** I am an overcomer; it is written upon me, for greater is He that is in me.
- 20 **I declare** I will not drown in the battles of life; I receive divine restoration after every storm.
- 21 **I decree** the Lord is my stronghold in the day of trouble, and He knows that I trust in Him (Nahum 1:7).
- 22 **I declare** supernatural turnaround over every situation that delayed my testimony.
- 23 **I decree** in this new month, testimonies upon testimonies without delay in my life and destiny.
- 24 **I declare** God is in the NOW — my help is here, my breakthrough is now, my storm is over.

## PART FOUR Prayer Points

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Pray each point fervently in the name of Jesus, organized by season of warfare.

### Thanksgiving

1. Father, I thank You for sustaining me and my family through every day of this month.
2. Thank You for the dangers I never saw and the attacks that never came near my dwelling.
3. Thank You that the traps of the wicked did not come to pass over my life and my loved ones.
4. Thank You, Lord, for covering me with Your feathers, for I have trusted under Your wings (Psalm 91:4).
5. I bless You for my going out and my coming in, and for crossing me over into a new month of testimony.

### Warfare

1. Every satanic storm sent against my life, I command you to reverse your direction now, in Jesus' name.
2. Every wind of failure and every wind of delay affecting my life, fade away by the fire of the Holy Ghost.
3. Every storm of fear, confusion, and anxiety assigned to my mind, be still in the name of Jesus.
4. Every household witchcraft monitoring my success, be scattered by the angels of the Lord.
5. Every evil altar and every evil priest ministering against my life, receive the sword of fire.
6. Lord, let Your voice silence every contrary voice speaking against my destiny.

### Family / Home

1. Every storm attacking my marriage and my home, be still in the name of Jesus.
2. Father, let Your peace reign in my heart, in my household, and in every avenue of my life.
3. Every storm affecting my children, be calm; cover and protect them in their going out and coming in.
4. No weapon formed against my family shall prosper; I soak my home in the blood of Jesus.
5. Let the peace of Christ rule and reign in every relationship under my roof.

## Destiny / New Month

1. Every storm assigned to sink my destiny, be still — my boat shall not sink and I shall reach my destination.
2. Father, grant me grace to see the end of my troubles and the end of my long-term struggles.
3. I receive a supernatural turnaround over every situation that has delayed my testimony.
4. Let new things, new levels, and new peace begin; let every debt be cancelled in Jesus' name.
5. In this new month, I decree testimonies upon testimonies, without delay, in my life and destiny.

## **PART FIVE** Reflection & Journaling

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Sit with the Lord. Write honestly. Let the “even now” faith take root.

**What storm is God calling you to declare over today — and will you name it specifically before Him?**

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**What does “even now” mean for your situation? Write the prayer you have been afraid to ask.**

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**Where have you been relating to Jesus as a “gardener” instead of Savior and Lord?**

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**List three storms you have already overcome. How do they remind you that you are an overcomer?**

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**What expectation about how God “should” show up do you need to release as an act of deliverance?**

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**Write your decree: complete the sentence — “The God who calmed the sea will calm \_\_\_\_\_ in my life.”**
